## **1. Explanatory note**

### 1.1. Goals and objectives of the course (module)

The goal of the course “Religion in world politics” is to form knowledge and understanding about the influence of world religions on the development of modern world order and the role of religious factor in current international relations.

The objectives of the discipline:

- 1) To get the students acquainted with religious factor in the modern international (Foreign Affairs) and with the main approaches to study of it.
- 2) To get students acquainted with the history and formation of the modern religious systems and of their influence on the international relations.
- 3) to understand the logic of formation of modern denominational religious systems
- 4) To study religious situation in the modern world

### 1.2. The place of the discipline in the structure of OOP Bachelor.

The content and methods of the course “Religion and world politics” is connected with the courses “History of world civilizations”, “World politics”. The course “Religion in world politics” allows the students to study the influence of religious ideas and confessional religious organizations on the development of political processes.

For the mastery of this course “Religion in world politics” the students are required to have general knowledge on history and skills of historical source analysis that they acquired through “History of world civilizations” course.

Successful completion of “Religion in world politics” is a necessary conditions for taking courses “Modern conflicts and problems their settlement”, “World politics”, “History of international relations”.

### 1.3. The competence of the bachelor graduate formed in the course of this discipline OOP VPO.

After the completion of OOP Bachelor, a graduate will be able to follow the professors instructions within their professional responsibilities based on the knowledge and skills (PK-9), ability to work with mass media materials, to compose press reviews on a given topic, to find and collect and analyze the factual material, making reasonable conclusions (PK-14); ability to orient in the main modern tendencies of world development, global political processes, understanding of the perspectives and possible implication for Russia (PDK-1); ability and skills to follow the dynamic of the main characteristics of international security and understanding of their influence on the national security of Russia (PDK-3).
